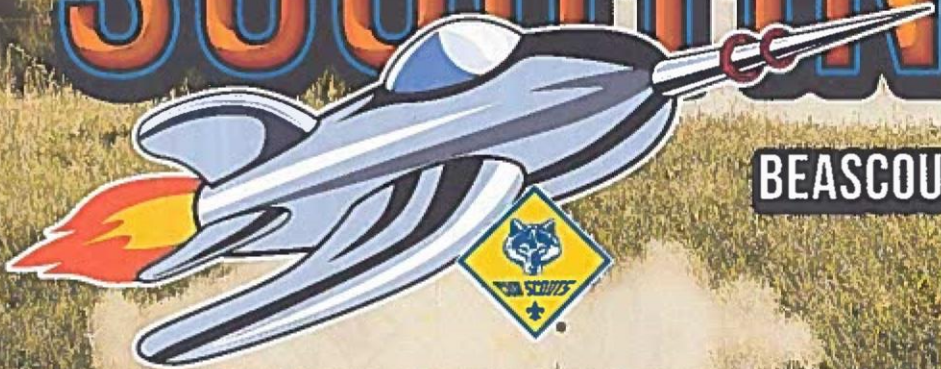

The Cub Scouting Program

The Cub Scouting program is a year-round program that boys can join at any time. It is flexible enough to work with other programs in which boys might also be involved.

How Much Does Scouting Cost?

Cuanto cuesta participar en programa del Scouting?

Registration Fee - Annual fee for youth and leaders.....\$24.00
This fee is sent to the National organization annually for each Scout and Leader.

Pago de entrada - Matricula anual para jovenes y líderes. El pago de entrada se enviara a la Organización Nacional anualmente para cada Scout y líder.

Accident and Sickness Insurance.....\$1.00

Secondary insurance covering registered members for Scouting activities.

Seguros de accidente y enfermedad. Seguro secundario de los miembros registrados para actividades de Scouting.

Boys' Life Magazine - Optional, but strongly recommended.....\$12.00

The leader's fee includes a subscription to *Scouting* magazine
Revista de Boys Life - Opcional, pero muy recomendable. El pago de entrada del líder incluye una suscripción a la revista Scouting.

Pack Dues - The amount varies by pack. Money-earning projects are conducted to fund the annual budget needed to run the pack program. This fall, all Scouts will be invited to sell popcorn to earn the money they need for a quality program.

Cuotas del Pack - La cantidad varía según el Pack. Proyectos para ganar dinero se llevan a cabo para financiar el presupuesto anual necesario para ejecutar el programa del pack. Este otoño, todos los Scouts serán invitados a vender palomitas para ganar el dinero que necesitan para un programa de calidad.

Uniform - The uniform and its cost vary by program for both youth and adults. See www.scoutingstuff.org for details and current prices.
